Go native and save the river

ATTENTION keen gardeners. Want to learn some new skills and help protect the biodi-

versity of native plants and animals? Then sign up for one of the TAFE-accredited Growers for Greenspace courses being

offered by a group of Sydney councils. The free courses teach participants how to propagate and grow native plants in their backyards or balconies for replanting in the Parramatta River catchment.
Ashfield firefighter Bill McCarthy re-

cently completed one of the courses and is now nurturing seedlings for replanting at vegetation sites in Riverglade Reserve, Hunters Hill.

"It's a very worthwhile thing to do that's also beneficial to the individual," he said. "Once you start getting into it, you can

develop a passion for it."

As well as learning about native plant growing, Mr McCarthy said participants learned "little bits of botany"


